- 1. Completed application

The student statement of interest should be as follows:

- A paragraph (or two) that tells us how you heard about SDMT Academy and why you want to attend one
 of their classes, workshops or productions.
- It should include reasons for applying for the scholarship.
- Please list other activities or youth organizations that you have participated in, and provide examples that demonstrate your commitment to activities over time.
- Remember that we want to hear your own unique ideas and words, please make sure the statement that
 you submit is your own work.
