SAN DIEGO MUSICAL THEATRE Catch Me If You Can at SDMT Stage

San Diego Musical Theatre opens its 2022 season with a splashy spectacle that follows the high-flying adventures of a globetrotting con artist.

Based on the hit Dreamworks film and the incredible true story, *Catch Me If You Can* is the high-flying musical comedy about chasing your dreams and not getting caught. Nominated for four Tony awards, including Best Musical, this delightfully entertaining show was created by a Tony Award-winning "dream team," with a book by Terrence McNally (The Full Monty, Ragtime) and a swinging score by Marc Shaiman and Scott Wittman (Hairspray).

Seeking fame and fortune, precocious teenager, Frank Abagnale, Jr., runs away from home to begin an unforgettable adventure. With nothing more than his boyish charm, a big imagination and millions of dollars in forged checks, Frank successfully poses as a pilot, a doctor and a lawyer–living the high life and winning the girl of his dreams. When Frank's lies catch the attention of FBI agent, Carl Hanratty, though, Carl pursues Frank across the country to make him pay for his crimes.

Richard Dueñez Morrison, SDMT's new resident Music Director, will provide music direction for *Catch Me If You Can*, the debut show of SDMT 2022 Season.

Catch Me If You Can will be directed by SDMT fan favorite and accomplished actor and director, Allison Spratt Pearce. Pearce's Broadway & Off-Broadway credits include: Curtains, Good Vibrations, Cry Baby, Enter Laughing, Cabaret. SD Highlights include: Jane in Emma, Phoebe in As You Like It (The Old Globe), Janice in Come From Away, Victoria in Sideways (La Jolla Playhouse), Amalia in She Loves Me, Maria in The Sound of Music, Judy in 9 to 5 (SDMT), Emily in Disgraced, Suzanna in Black Pearl Sings (SDREP), Louise in Gypsy, Eliza in My Fair Lady and Katherine in The Last Wife (Cygnet)

"While Frank Jr.'s real life, movie and this musical adaptation have some plot differences, they all share one major theme, the 'Art of Deception'. Regardless of your relationship to

and knowledge of this story, we ask you to look at our production with fresh eyes," said Pearce. "Though set in the late '60's, as a female director, I wanted to bend a few stereotypes and roles under the umbrella of our theme: things and people aren't always what they appear to be. The score written by Shaiman and Wittman brilliantly furthers the plot and provides detail about the internal struggles, vulnerabilities, and conflicts of the characters' thoughts and history. This show begs you to ask the question: What IS the truth?"

Xavier J. Bush is jazzed to be joining the SDMT team! Seen both on stage and been behind the table for many productions coast to coast. Most recently Bush was seen as Richie Walters in *A Chorus Line* at The Moonlight and choreographed the Moonlight Youth Theatre production of *The Wizard of Oz.* Select choreography credits include: *The Hunchback of Notre Dame, Little Shop of Horrors, Guys and Dolls, The Wild Party,* and *Grease.* Director/Choreographer credits include *Legally Blonde the Musical* and *Disney's Beauty and the Beast.*

"Perception is one of the dominant themes we uncovered in our show planning sessions; specifically how people perceive us and how we present to the world," said Bush, Catch Me If You Can Choreographer. "Finding movement that will make the audience view the stage and the action happening on it differently throughout the show is a big part of my choreography mission. The cast is insanely talented and they are all able to not only execute whatever is given to them, but also tell a story as they do it!"

Catch Me If You Can is a big and bright spectacle that brings an authentic '60's musical vibe with high-energy dance numbers and a riveting story.
