(San Diego, CA March 28, 2025). San Diego Musical Theatre announces the second production of their 2025 season, *THE PROM*, May 2 - June 1, 2025 (press opening on Saturday, May 3) at the SDMT Stage in Kearny Mesa.

Telling the story of a young Indiana highschooler just trying to bring her girlfriend to the prom, the musical takes an unexpected turn when four eccentric Broadway performers descend on the town in an earnest, yet misguided, attempt to fight the injustice and share a bit of the spotlight again. With an incredible score and the enduring message that love can bring everyone together, The Prom captures the humor and heart of a classic musical comedy and resonates with audiences now more than ever.

"What inspires me most about this show is it is a celebration of the resilience of the queer community. This piece doesn't wave a magic wand and solve homophobia, and, unlike it's Netflix adaptation, it leaves characters with complications remaining in their journeys. Even with all of that, they still find and embrace joy, and there is so much power in that.
